Message from Our Director: Christina Marra

We have developed an amazing team at Oceanside Library that strives to provide excellent service. I am so proud of them. This year our circulation returned to pre-pandemic numbers (about 300,000 items) We had 161,237 library visits and over 77,000 visits to our "new" website. The Library offered many exciting programs and events both live and virtual, for patrons of all ages. Our Bookmobile continues to visit schools, senior centers, community events, and the homebound service delivers library items to patrons who cannot visit the library.

Having the continued support of the Board and public has made it possible for us to soar on many different levels. We are recognized nationally as leaders in the Library world, for our innovation and our ability to provide world-class services at a fiscally-responsible level.

I am pleased to report that this year's Library budget stays within the New York State tax cap, without diminishing any of the resources, programs or services we are providing the Oceanside community.



The Library Proposition is our request for an increase in our contract with the school district. This year, despite inflation, this request would result in the average Oceanside residence seeing an increase of approximately a little under \$25.00 per year or approximately \$2.00 per month per household.

We are excited about the year ahead as we build our future Library. The Library continues to serve as the center of our community - providing full services and will do so throughout the construction. We will continue to reach all areas, providing service and programming for all.

We thank this wonderful community for your support, and all of the patrons who utilize our services. With your continued support, we will serve our mission every day for years to come!

BUDGET PROPOSITION 2023

The annual appropriation for Library services of \$7,035,969 heretofore authorized by the voters is hereby increased by the amount of \$322,061 for a total annual appropriation of \$7,358,030 for each year commencing July 1, 2023, together with the Library's designated share of any payments by LIPA pursuant to a settlement under case index #403754/2016, representing the amount necessary for Library services pursuant to the written contract between the Board of Education of the Oceanside Union Free School District and the Oceanside Library.

OCEANSIDE LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Oceanside Library is an independent agency and is not associated with any other board or governmental agency. Its Board of Trustees is solely responsible for the administration and policies of the Library. Trustees receive no compensation and pay taxes at the regular rate. The budget is prepared by the seven- member Board of Trustees with the help of the library staff and is voted upon independently by residents of the Oceanside School District. By law, the School District acts as tax agent for the Library.




