With the incredible support you have given us, we continue to provide full services while we prepare to move back to our new facility.



The dedicated and talented team at Oceanside Library strives to provide excellent service and continues to serve this wonderful community with innovative services. We have used our time in the temporary facility to completely overhaul many of our "back-office" systems and to prepare for new and expanded programs and services when we return to the building.

With the continued support of the Board and the public, the Library continues to serve as the center of our community -- reaching all areas, providing world class services and offering programs to patrons of all ages at a fiscally-responsible level.

Our program attendance and circulation of library materials continues to soar, with circulation exceeding pre-pandemic levels. Visits to our newly-renovated website more than doubled from the previous year. We enhanced our author visits and continue to provide numerous programs and social opportunities for seniors and special needs patrons. Our Bookmobile is out and about in the community, visiting schools, senior centers, community events, and local businesses and making homebound deliveries to patrons who cannot visit the Library.

I am pleased to report that this year's Library budget stays within the New York State tax cap without diminishing any of the resources, programs or services we are providing to the Oceanside community. On May 21st, the Library budget will appear as a Proposition on the school district ballot. The Library Proposition is our request for an increase in our contract with the school district. This year, in spite of inflation, this request would result in the average Oceanside residence seeing an increase of approximately \$19.00 per year per household, or approximately \$1.58 per month per household.

We are excited about the progress of the construction project and we cannot wait to welcome you into our new building. It's getting CLOSE! You can check out the latest videos of the construction on our Youtube page and follow all aspects of the project at oceansidevision2020.com.

BUDGET PROPOSITION 2024

The annual appropriation for Library services of \$7,358,030 heretofore authorized by the voters is hereby increased by the amount of \$249,113 for a total annual appropriation of \$7,607,143 for each year commencing July 1, 2024, together with the Library's designated share of any payments by LIPA pursuant to a settlement under case index #403754/2016, representing the amount necessary for Library services pursuant to the written contract between the Board of Education of the Oceanside Union Free School District and the Oceanside Library.

OCEANSIDE LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Oceanside Library is an independent agency and is not associated with any other board or governmental agency. Its Board of Trustees is solely responsible for the administration and policies of the Library. Trustees receive no compensation and pay taxes at the regular rate. The budget is prepared by the seven-member Board of Trustees with the help of the library staff and is voted upon independently by residents of the Oceanside School District. By law, the School District acts as tax agent for the Library.
