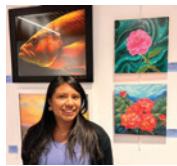
### Comedy Shows:

# A Note From The Director Chris Marra



## NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

This past year has been truly transformative for Oceanside Library. On October 27, 2024, we proudly opened the doors to our new building, marking the beginning of an exciting new chapter. With expanded space and enhanced services, the Library has seen a significant increase in attendance and circulation, underscoring the value you place on your Library.

We continue to provide and expand our innovative programming, educational resources, and community services, including more movement programs for children, adult exercise programs, and tech help. Virtually every week we have been rolling out new services, like the Library of Things, the Seed and Cutting library, and more. Perhaps the greatest change, and challenge, has been the new Beacon space, the home for Oceanside's teens.

The Library's budget will appear as a proposition on the May 20th school district ballot. To sustain the high level of services, this year's budget request includes an increase of approximately \$36 per household for the year, or about \$3 per month. This modest adjustment will allow us to:

- Maintain and expand programming for all ages, including early literacy, teen engagement, senior services, programs for our special needs community, job preparation resources, cultural events, and more.
- Ensure proper upkeep of our new building and infrastructure.
- Continue providing cutting-edge technology, outreach programs, and community partnerships.
- Keep you and our staff protected.

As we all know, we are facing significant economic challenges. The cumulative impact of years of inflation, increased health and energy costs, and more, are driving this year's budget. Heavily impacting our expenses is the addition of security personnel, a necessary but unfortunate expense. Finally, once again, we receive a pittance of State aid (approximately \$10,000 per year) meaning that virtually all of our income comes from you.

It is worth noting that we were able to complete the building without cutting any features and without having to ask you for more funds. This we did despite the post-COVID skyrocketing of interest rates and costs and never-ending supply chain issues. The taxes for the project, about \$140 per household, appeared in your July 2020 budget. No additional taxes for the construction have been or will be requested.

We are committed to being responsible stewards of the funds you give us, while providing the best possible services for you and your neighbors. Your support ensures that Oceanside Library remains a cornerstone of learning, creativity, and community engagement.

If you haven't visited our new building yet, we invite you to stop by for a tour and experience all we have to offer.

Thank you for your continued trust and support—we look forward to serving you in the years ahead. Your Library is here for you!

## BUDGET PROPOSITION 2025:

The annual appropriation for Library services of \$7,607,143 heretofore authorized by the voters is hereby increased by the amount of \$499,489 for a total annual appropriation of \$8,106,632 for each year commencing July 1, 2025, together with the Library's designated share of any payments by LIPA pursuant to a settlement under case index #403754/2016, representing the amount necessary for Library services pursuant to the written contract between the Board of Education of the Oceanside Union Free School District and the Oceanside Library.
